What is e2e?

Entry to Employment (E2E) is an entry to work-based programme for young people aged 16 to 18 who are not yet ready or able to enter an apprenticeship, Further Education such as a college course, or employment.

How can e2e help me?

e2e is designed to meet the needs of the individual. You will be given ongoing support from both your tutor and your Connexions advisor. e2e gives you the chance to make new friends and develop new skills. e2e will help you with:

- Building confidence
- Literacy and numeracy skills
- Team building
- Experience of the world of work

How long is the programme?

The programme will usually last 22 weeks, but if additional support is needed you are most welcome to extend this time. What financial support can I apply for?

You will be able to apply for an Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA). This is dependent upon total household income. Please see the following website for details:
